

School Bus Transportation Safety Rules

Parents

Before morning trip starts	Wait at home pick up area at least 5 minutes earlier before the bus arrival
During school hours	Always be ready to receive any call from the school.
Departure from school	Ensure that there is someone to receive your child (under age 11) from the bus when they're back from school.
Home drop off	Receive your children (Under age 11) when they are back from school and help your child get off the bus .

Students

Home pick up	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Head straight to the bus pick up area at least 5 minutes earlier. • Don't play around. • Don't go far from the bus pick up area. • Don't run towards the bus. • Wait for the school bus until it comes to a complete stop. • Wait for a sign from the bus driver or the bus supervisor to get on the bus. • Wait for the bus in the queue with younger students at the front. • Don't push or pull when getting on the bus. • Use the handrail and watch your steps. • Sit in your assigned seat and fasten the seatbelt (if any).
Departure from school	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Go to your bus waiting area. • Wait in the queue and don't push or pull when getting on the bus. • Use the handrail and watch your steps.





Home Drop Off

- follow the bus supervisor's instruction and the school management.
- Keep seated until the bus comes to a complete stop.
- Follow the instructions of the bus supervisor and driver.
- Cross the road with the assistance of the bus supervisor (for students below 11 years).
- For older students, cross the road safely after looking carefully (left,right,ahead,& behind).
- Take 10 steps away from the bus so the driver can see you (see below picture).
- Don't go back near the bus if you drop any thing.
- Avoid standing under the sunlight and talking to strangers.
